El foso exterior y <sup>de</sup> cubierta, se forman de palastro galvanizado; y el foso o pasad interior, de dicho metal o de madera. En el precio el coste de la Tienda con sus accesorios, es de L. 150. <sup>(14.250 reales, próximamente)</sup> y en el 2.º de L. 120. (11.400 reales próximamente)

Entre las armaduras exterior e interior, se dejan espacios para la libre circulación del aire, con el objeto de mantener en la tienda una temperatura fresca, principalmente en verano.

Los pies derechos, armadura del techo se, son de hierro forjado y fundido, según la aplicación de las piezas, bien preparados para evitar los efectos de la humedad; y el conjunto <sup>se</sup> dispuesto de tal modo, que dispensa toda construcción con otro material.

La simplicidad de la construcción, hace que se establezcan <sup>las tiendas,</sup> en el terreno en muy corto tiempo, sin necesidad de operarios especiales, y que puedan transportarse con facilidad de un punto a otro.

La Lam.<sup>a</sup> hace ver la distribución de las camas, que son de hierro, y ~~se abren~~ durante el día se abren, dejando así mayor espacio interior en la tienda. En ~~ella~~ se

manifiesta tambien la situacion de las mesas y asientos para  
el uso de la tropa.

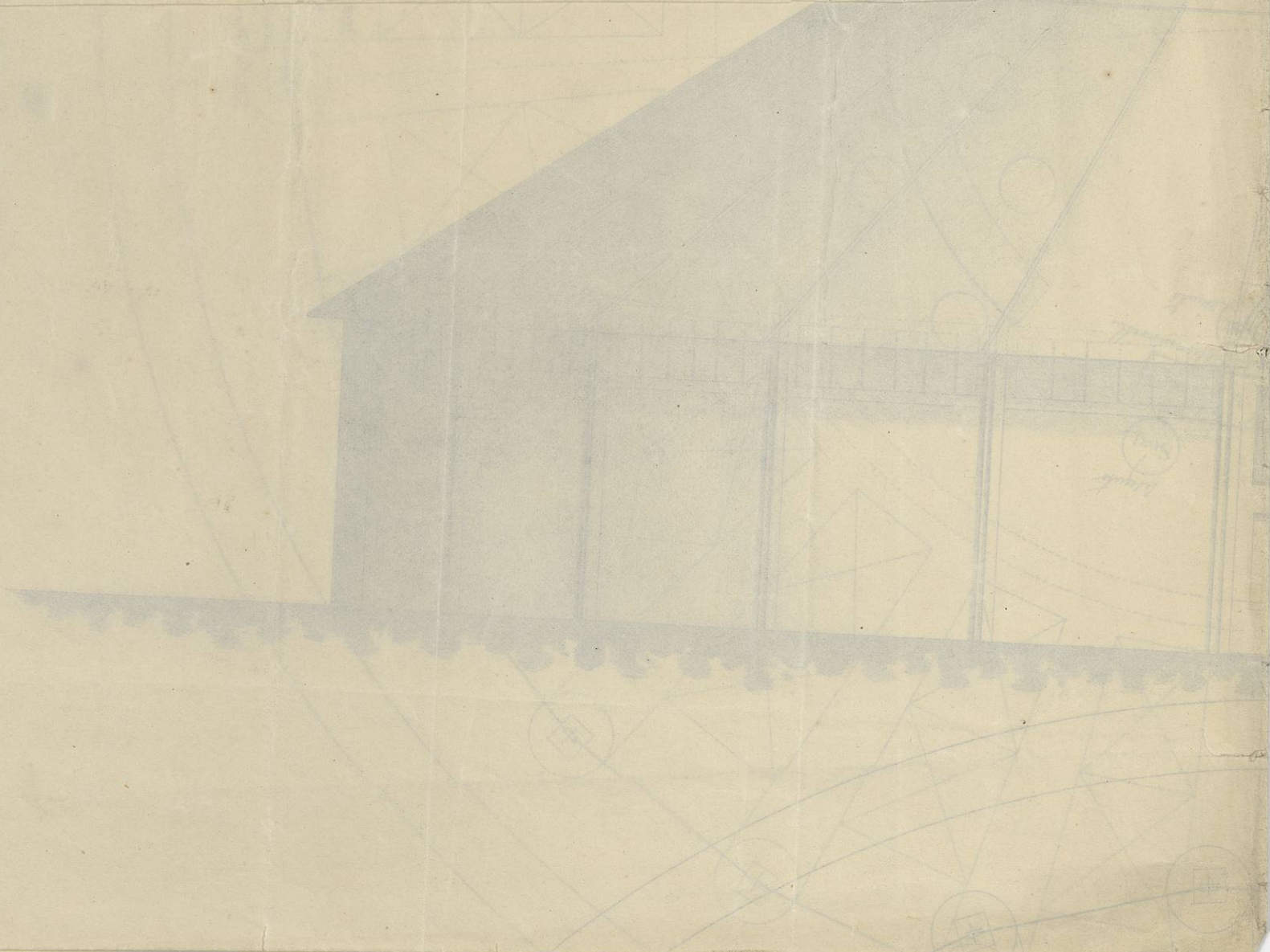
The outside and roof to be of corrugated iron casing on the inside with fibrous slab or prepared boarding (lathes or spaces for the circulation of air will be made between the outside of the tent and inside casing so as to keep the inside perfectly cool.

The whole of the framing and supports to be of wrought iron and cast iron well coated with mineral paint and so arranged as to dispense with brick or stone foundations.

The simplicity of construction admits of these tents being erected in a very short time without the aid of any skilled workmen and can be easily removed from place to place.

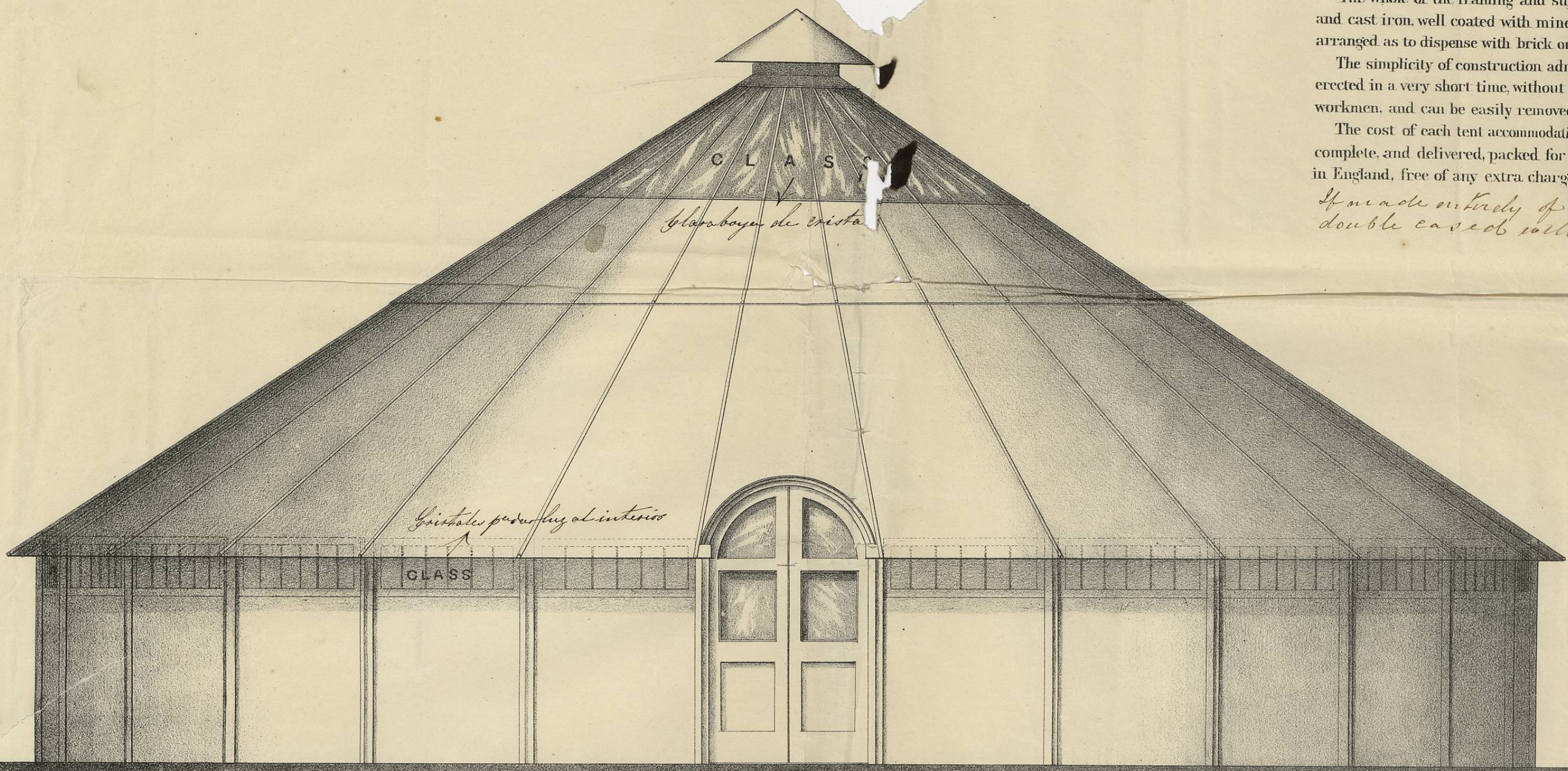
The cost of each tent accommodating 25 men is £120 complete and delivered packed for shipment at the port in England, free of any extra charges.

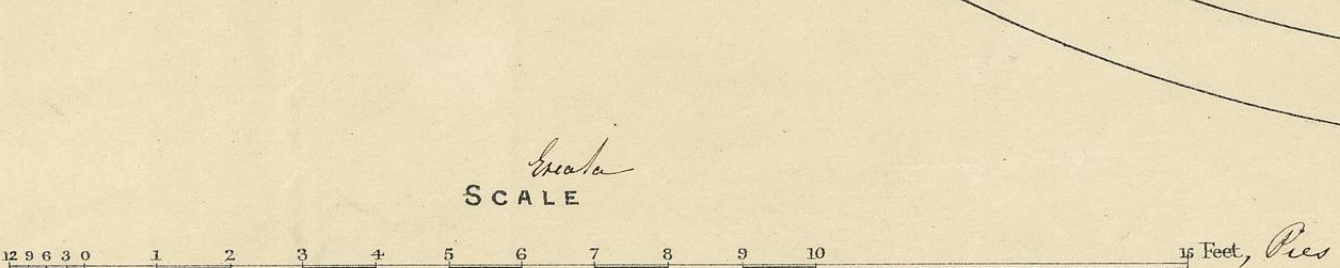
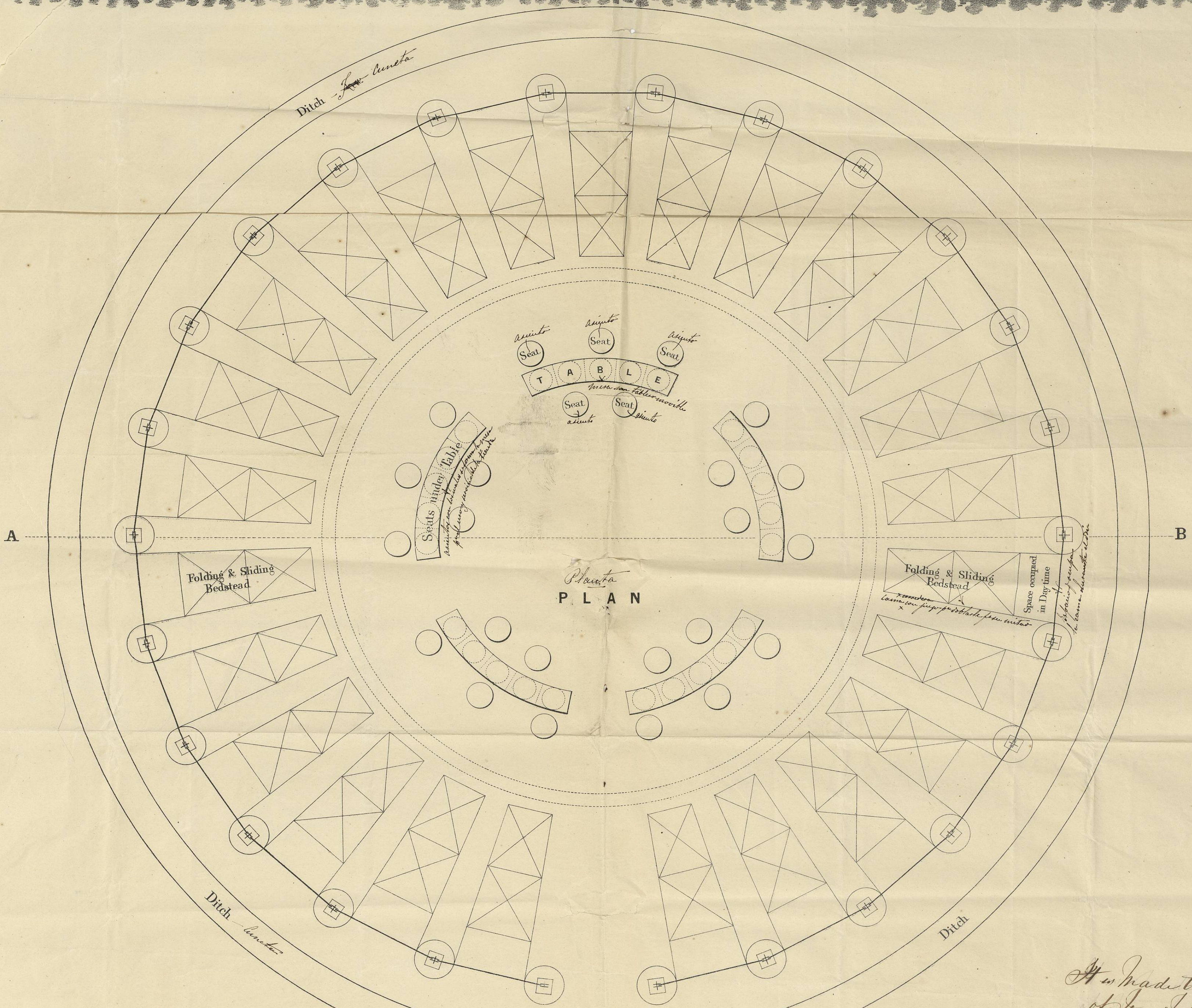


*Vienda de Campaña de Horno para 25 Hombrs.*

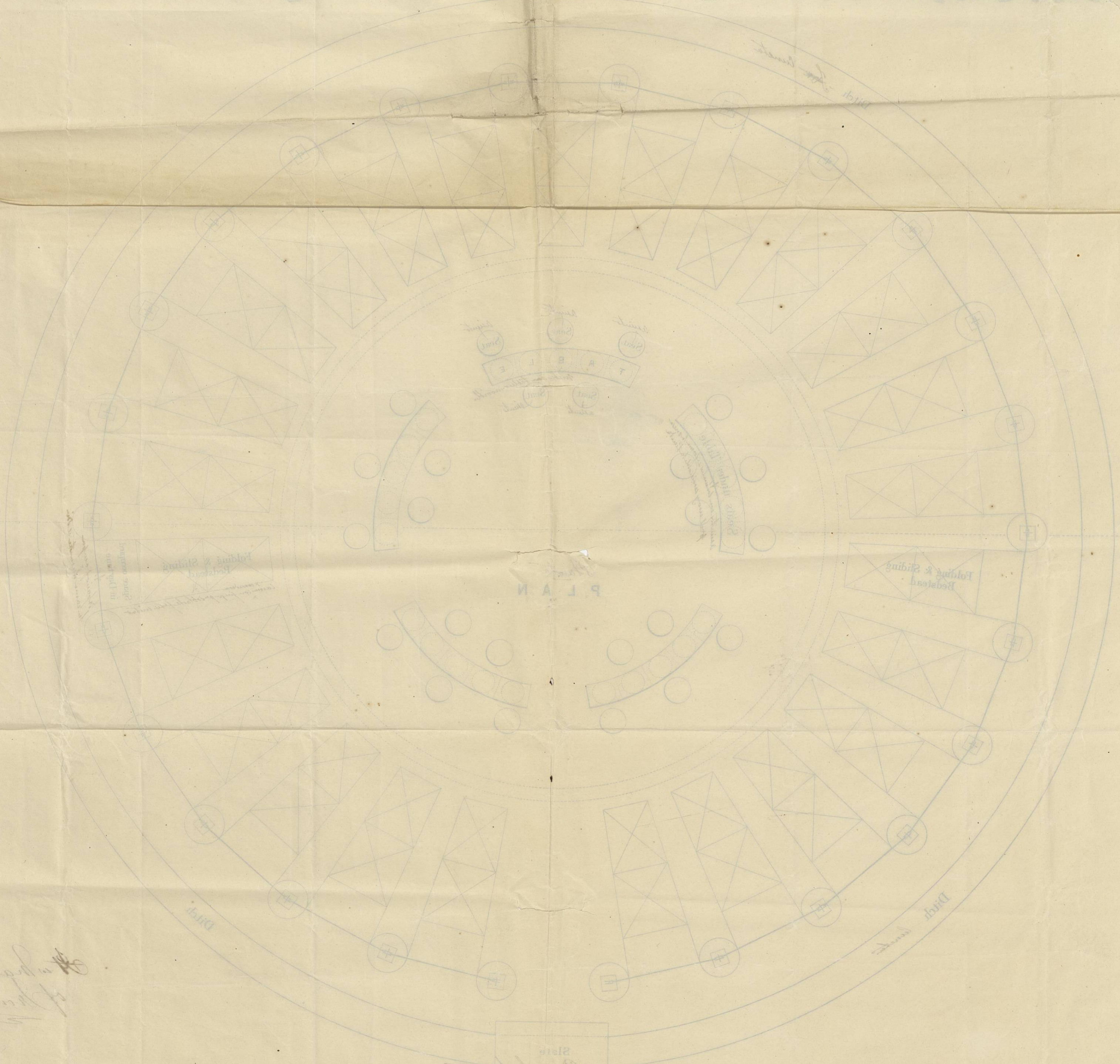

The outside and roof to be of corrugated iron, covered on the inside with fibrous slab or porous boarding (leaving spaces for the circulation of air) which will be made between the outside of the tent and inside casing so as to keep the inside perfectly cool.  
The whole of the framing and supports to be of wrought iron and cast steel coated with mineral paint, and so arranged as to support with perfect stability the fibrous slab or porous boarding.  
The simplicity of construction admits of these tents being erected in a very short time without the aid of any skilled workmen, and can be easily removed from place to place.  
The cost of each tent is approximately £25, and is complete and ready for shipment in any part of England free of carriage charges.
